



FIG.1 Derating Curve Output Rectified Current




FIG.2 Typical Forward Characteristics per Diode




FIG.3 Maximum Non-Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current per Diode




FIG.4 Typical Reverse Characteristics per Diode





FIG.5 Typical Junction Capacitance per Diode
